

St Mary's Aiken Game Day Protocols

Temperatures will be taken at the entrance for anyone wishing to enter the gym. The visiting team will enter through our gym's middle doors. The Home team will enter through the door closest to the gate. All fans will be required to wear a mask upon entry.

Players and spectators arriving for the first game of the night should arrive no sooner than 30 minutes prior to game time. After the first game, players and coaches of the following games will be allowed into the gym 15 minutes prior to their game time and will be directed to the stage area for seating. Spectators for the games that follow will not be allowed into the gym until the gym has been emptied.

Players should arrive in uniform as there will not be locker rooms available.

The teams will need to exit immediately after their game. The visitors will exit out of the side door closest to their team's bench.

The home team will exit immediately out the same door they entered.

Coaches, scorekeepers, timekeepers, volunteers, etc., will also be required to wear a mask. Players will be required to wear a mask upon entry. While on the court, masks will not be worn. However, players sitting on the bench will be required to wear a mask.

Seating capacity will be limited. We will have 15 spaces available for each team. These will be marked. A family of 2 would be able to sit in one of the designated spots. Players will be limited to 2 spectators. We will ask that fans leave after their child's game so that we may bring in the next group of spectators.

We will be unable to host cheerleaders due to our limited capacity.

Entry will be \$5.00 per adult and \$2.00 per student.

Players should bring a water bottle. There will be a water cooler for each team.

Visiting teams will need to bring warm up balls.

Hand sanitizer stations will be available at each team bench and upon entry to the gym and at the scorers' table.

Players' benches will be sanitized between games. Bleachers will be cleaned. Game balls will be sanitized between games and at the end of every quarter. Balls entering the stands will be traded out at the scorers' table for a freshly sanitized ball.

Spectators and players who do not abide by the above protocols may be asked to remove themselves from the gym.
